## Explanation of Responses:

(1) Represents shares subject to performance-based restricted stock units ("PSUs") granted on June 28, 2013 and on August 1, 2014, that were subject to performance requirements, which were attained over a period ending December 31, 2015. One third of the earned shares vested each on Dec. 31, 2016 and Dec. 2017. The remaining shares shall vest on Dec. 31, 2018, provided the recipient remains in continuous service with the Company on each such vesting date.

(2) Represents shares subject to performance-contingent restricted stock units ("RSUs") granted on April 3, 2017. One-third of the shares vest on each of April 3, 2018, 2019 and 2020, provided the recipient remains in continuous service with the Company on each such vesting date.

(3) Represents an unvested time-based restricted stock award granted on 4/1/2013 under Seacoast's 2000 Incentive Plan which shall vest in 25% increments beginning on the second anniversary of the date of the grant, and each of three anniversaries thereafter, subject to continued employment.

(4) Granted pursuant to Seacoast Banking Corporation of Florida's 2013 Incentive Plan

(5) Vests over 3 years in one-third increments each anniversary of the date of grant beginning on the first anniversary of the date of grant (the date indicated), subject to continuous employment on each vesting date and the Company's banking subsidiary meets certain capital requirements.

(6) Originally has two tiered vesting. Performance criteria was met, and time-based vesting began on 12/1/2016. Option vests in equal installments at the end of each month over the next 48 months, provided that Optionee remains in Continuous Service on each applicable vesting date.

(7) Originally had two tiered vesting. Criteria was met and time-based vesting began 7/1/2015. Option vests in equal installments beginning on the end of each month over the following 48 months, provided the Optionee remains in continuous service on each applicable vesting date.

(8) Vests over 3 years in one-third increments each anniversary of the date of grant beginning on the first anniversary of the date of grant (the date indicated), subject to continued employment.

(9) Vests over 5 years at the rate of 20% on the first anniversary of the date of grant (the date indicated) and then at the rate of 20% on each of the following four anniversaries thereafter, subject to continued employment.

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
