Rossi, each an independent director of the Company, as Plaintiffs, against the Company, Darwin Deason, Chairman of the Board, Lynn R. Blodgett, Director and CEO and President of the Company, and John Rexford, Director and Executive Vice President of the Company, as defendants, seeking an order declaring that plaintiffs did not breach their fiduciary duties to the Company and its stockholders in connection with the process followed by the independent directors related to the possible sale of the Company.
