(1) The total beneficial ownership includes 7.7531 shares at \$51.9377 per share acquired through dividends paid under the HP Share Ownership Plan ("SOP") on 01/06/10 with respect to shares held under the SOP.

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These shares were held indirectly under HP's 401(k) Plan as of 12/31/09. Fidelity Investments Institutional Services Company, Inc. accounts for holdings in the stock fund in units, which are comprised of stock and cash reserves. The shares reported represent an approximate value based upon the fund balance and market value of HP's common stock.

- (3) Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of HP common stock.

As previously reported, on 01/15/09 the reporting person was granted 28,710 restricted stock units ("RSUs"), 14,355 of which vested on 01/15/10, and 14,355 of which will vest on 01/15/11. Dividend equivalent rights accrue with respect to these RSUs when and as

- (4) dividends are paid on HP common stock. The number of derivative securities beneficially owned in column 9 includes 44.0169 dividend equivalent rights at \$52.18 per RSU credited to the reporting person's account on 01/06/10, and a de minimus adjustment of .4197 due to fractional rounding of the dividend equivalent rights.

As previously reported, on 12/10/09 the Reporting Person was granted 32,109 restricted stock units ("RSUs"), 16,054 of which will vest on 12/10/10 and 16,055 of which will vest on 12/10/11. Dividend equivalent rights accrue with respect to these RSUs when and as

- (5) dividends are paid on HP common stock. The 49.2281 dividend equivalent rights being reported reflect 49.2281 dividend equivalent rights at \$52.18 per RSU credited to the Reporting Person's account on 01/06/10.
