* On October 5, 2012, pursuant to that Agreement and Plan of Merger dated as of April 29, 2012, as amended by Amendment No. 1 thereto dated as of June 15, 2012, by and among Energy Transfer Partners, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership (ETP), Energy Transfer Partners GP, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership, Sam Acquisition Corporation, a Pennsylvania corporation and wholly owned subsidiary of ETP (Merger Sub), Sunoco, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation, and, for limited purposes set forth therein, Energy Transfer Equity, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership, Merger Sub merged with and into Sunoco (the Merger), with Sunoco surviving the Merger. In light of the foregoing, Sunoco has filed a post-effective amendment on Form S-8 with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the SEC) to terminate the offering of unsold shares of common stock and related plan interests offered under the Plan, and the Plan is filing this Form 15 with the SEC to deregister the plan interests and to suspend the Plan s duty to file reports under Section 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended.
